




#### U.S. COVID-19 Tests Conducted vs. the COVID-19 Positive Test Rate

March 5, 2020 - September 2, 2020



### **CDC Reported COVID-19 Deaths and Selected Recorded Comorbidities**



February 1, 2020 - September 2, 2020




